Any professional development plan whose terms have not been fulfilled by the end of the term of application may result in a student not being admitted to advanced study.
- UNDERGRADUATE LISTSERV-** Valuable information about deadlines and special programs will be disseminated through the listserv, and you are responsible for the information given. - STUDENT TEACHING DEADLINE-** Student teaching applications are due 1 ½ years in advance of the expected student teaching semester. The student teaching application is available ONLINE at [www.ehhs.kent.edu/OCE](http://www.ehhs.kent.edu/OCE). Submit the application online by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday of the Fall semester. Failure to meet these deadlines could result in a delay in student teaching.
